

Continued from the MARCH - APRIL 1974 Issue.



Cacheted envelope with 55 Bani imprinted stamp showing three runners, Text: Sportivi Inderlimit Normele Remtrmaparticipida at top left and Jocurile Olympice pe la Tokio at bottom left below the runners. Size 150 x 102 mm.

27 MEXICO Commemorating XIX Olympic Summer Games Mexico City 1968.

(D) Envelope for air mail with 80 cts imprinted stamp, Text: use y coleccions estampillas postales Olimpicas (use and collect the postage stamps of the Olympics). Illustrated with the air post label with aeroplane in bottom left hand corner.

1) Text in blue color.

2) Text in black color. (Also known with stamp incorrectly printed). Mexico also issued a telegram form and envelope. The envelope is printed in blue and at the bottom in red 'use y coleccions los timbres postales Olimpicos'. Size 166 x 93 mm.

28 RUSSIA in connection with the 10th Olympic Winter Games Grenoble, France 1968.

(F) Cacheted envelope with 4k different color coat of arms pattern and year 1966 imprinted stamp (type Scott 3260) as item A - E but three snowflake design circles with a skier, an ice hockey player or a skater in each all above the 5 rings.

### 32 JAPAN commemorating the 11th Winter Olympic Games Sapporo Japan 1972

Japan issued a variety of different postal stationery as advance publicity for the 11th Winter Olympic Games. Many of the items listed were issued in connection with other events such as the annual snow festival, the international winter sports meeting, etc. As they all refer to the Sapporo Winter Olympic Games in some way they are included in this series.

A. Folding letter form with 15 yen imprinted stamp. Text (in Japanese) 21 Sapporo Festival 29.1 - 1.2.70 illustration Abu - Simbel Tempel and Olympic emblem Sapporo 72.

- 1) Text in green printing.
- 2) Text in yellow printing.

B. Postcard with 7 yen imprinted stamp. Text in English and Japanese: The 21st Sapporo Snow Festival, illustrated various people, Welcome Tower and Olympic emblem. In Odori Park, Sapporo.

- 1) Illustrations and text in light brown printing.
- 2) Illustrations and text in dark brown printing.

C. Postcard with 7 yen imprinted stamp. Text in Japanese: All Hokkaido Postage Stamp Exhibition illustrated with the official Winter Olympic Emblem Sapporo in quad format.

Recently I wrote to Busek to thank him for a copy of his book and much to my surprise and also deep sorrow, I received a note in the form of a death announcement explaining that he had died recently after a long illness, and surprisingly enough, Busek was a priest.

If any SPI members have access to this fine sports work, you are lucky as much can be learned from it. Philately has lost another fine student.

### LETS POOL OUR OLYMPIC AND SPORTS KNOWLEDGE

Q-29 I have in my collection a flown cover from Monterrey, Mexico with the Olympic machine slogan "Use and Collect Olympic Postage Stamps." On the date stamp "Monterrey, N.L./Correos/ 27 Apr. HOWEVER THE YEAR NUMERALS ARE INVERTED -8691 instead of 1968. Can anyone explain how this inversion occurred? Has anyone else seen it? Is it rare? For how long a period of time was this year numeral inversion in use? I would appreciate any information about it.

A-26 The response to the question about "Japanese Mihon Overprints" has been very gratifying. Many thanks to Joe Schirmer, Dave Bressler, Joachim B. Kortuem and Atsushi Sekimoto (Japan) for providing the following information which was gathered from the Meikan Catalog (Japan Special), the American Philatelist (Vol 79 No. 6, March 1966) and Japanese Philately (Vol. 25: No. 3, June 1970.)

The word "Mihon" is Japanese (originally compounded from the two Chinese characters) "MI" ("to see") and "HON" ("source or origin) Compounded the word "Mihon" means "Sample" or "Specimen". The purpose of the "Mihon" is to announce the issuance of a stamp. These specimens were to acquaint post office personnel, both at home and abroad, with new stamps about to be put into circulation. "Mihon" specimens are forwarded to the U.P.U. The overprints negate the postal validity. In 1958 the Postal Communications and Telegraph Service endeavored to promote stamp collecting as part of the general education program in Japan. This "school campaign", launched by the Ministry, was a success and

for the rise of Mihon overprints from 16,300 in 1957 to 61,500 in 1958.

We next take up the question of the colors used for the overprints. The Japanese Gov't. Printing Bureau decided on the color of the overprints. This decision is based on the stamp's color. If the color of the stamp is dark, the color red is usually used for the lettering "Mihon". Black is used for light colored stamps.

Finally, there is the question of the so-called "Mihon" forgeries on the six souvenir sheets issued on Aug. 20, 1964 for the Tokyo Games. Opinions differ about their authenticity. Many of the characters are uneven in size and spacing. The easiest way of detecting the "Mihon" varieties are by measuring the three "Mihon" characters.


Width: 14.5 mm (standard) ---- 10.5 mm (variety)

Height: 3.5 mm (standard) ---- 2.5 to 3.2 mm (variety)

A. Sekimoto of Japan writes about these varieties, "I investigated them very carefully and found that they are all genuine specimens. I asked a man who was a government official of the postal service, why are there so many varieties of lettering "Mihon" of the Tokyo Olympic Fund S/S's, he answered that at the time, Government Printing Bureau was very busy so that the overprint work was sublet to some private printing factories."

A detailed account of the examination of these varieties is reported in Japanese Philately, Vol. 25: No. 3 June 1970 pgs. 112-114. J. R. Hughes and Mr. Montgomery claim they are forgeries. Then again Atsushi Sekimoto's explanation is quite plausible....take your pick!

### LIGHTING OF THE OLYMPIC TORCH AT OLYMPIA

The ceremony took place at noon on January 30, 1976. The Torch was then carried by runners to the village of Platanos, on to Andraavida Aerodrome and flown to the Athens airport. There, on the same afternoon, the Torch in solemn ceremony was handed to representatives of the Austrian Olympic Committee, who at once boarded their plane and flew to Vienna.

The Greek Posts had three special postmarks prepared for mail posted during these ceremonies, which were only used on the 30th Jan. One at Olympia, and at Athens, one for the "handing over" to the Austrians and the third for the Torch bearing flight Athens-Vienna. The Three types of postmarks are the same. The wording is different in each.



## POISON GAS & OLYMPIC STAMPS

by Joseph E. Schirmer

Over the years there have been three governments in Yemen; namely; Yemen; Mutawakelite Kingdom of Yemen and the Yemen Arab Republic. With three governments operating simultaneously, one can well imagine the confusion caused in various government agencies and especially the postal division. While all three governments issued stamps by the

basket full, it took the Mutawakelite Kingdom of Yemen to pull off one of the classic ripoffs to collectors.

On 26 June 1967 they issued five overprinted Olympic stamps; two from the Tokyo and three from the Mexico Olympic Preparation issue. They were overprinted with new values along with a skull and cross bones. A 50% surtax on the sale of these stamps was imposed, provided you had a letter of authorization to purchase same. Approximately 12,500 sets were issued for "sale". They were supposedly issued to help pay medical expenses for persons hit with poison gas during the many "wars" and skirmishes going on in Yemen.


