CARRYING THE OLYMPIC TORCH

Quite often Olympic philatelic collecting takes on an interesting turn from unexpected sources. Such was the case when a co-worker informed me that a relative of his carried the Olympic torch. I asked him to find out in which Olympiad his cousin carried the flame. He explained, a few days later, that his cousin Binney married a Greek boy from Olympia who carried the torch for the 16th Olympiad. Realizing it would be unique to have his signature on the Quantas Olympic Torch Flight Cover, I requested my friend to forward the cover to Olympia for his autograph. I waited five months for the cover to be returned. I had just about given up hope when I received a reply from Greece.

The following was written by Binney Panagopoulos, wife of Kosta Panagopoulos, as the torch bearer does not write English, "Dear Mr. Epstein, I am sure you are well informed as to all the facts of the Olympic Games and traditions. And one custom which I believe is still used is a sort of unwritten law where the first seven runners are to be from Olympia and the best athlete of the seven will receive the flame and be the first runner. Of course it was a very exciting time - especially when the seven are picked and then waiting to hear your name to be the first runner. I was nineteen at the time and carried the flame just about one mile, it was taken from the altar (at that time it was just outside of the archaeological site) through the town of Olympia. It took a little persuasion at the time but the runners were allowed to keep the torches which they ran..."



As any flame on a prop airliner causes an extreme fire hazard there has been rumor that Qantas Airlines never really carried the Olympic flame to Melbourne. This rumor is dispelled by the following letter to C. Robert Paul, Jr., Director of Communications for the United States Olympic Committee, from the Commissioner of the National Football League, Pete Rozelle who was, at the time, Publicity Director for the Qantas Torch Flight. He wrote, "Your letter brought back fond memories. The Olympic flame was transported from Greece to Australia by Qantas in two miners lamps that were in a protected area of the plane. It was not extinguished.

Incidentally, as I recall, the torch bearer did not get the expected welcome when he arrived from the Sidney Town Hall (or whatever) enroute to Melbourne. It seems he was preceded by a few minutes by a college student prankster carrying a flame in a tin can mounted on a broom stick. The latter received the initial adulation on the unsuspecting crowd."

The Olympic Torch flight route was via Athens, Istanbul, Basra, Karachi, Calcutta, Bangkok, Singapore and Port Darwin. It covered 8,545 statute miles. From Port Darwin the torch was then relayed 2,831 miles to Melbourne.

Olympic and Sport Stamps---

"THE BLACK BLOT" by Joe Schirmer, Associate Editor

Whether or not we tend to agree with it, the American Philatelic Society **Black Blot** program is here to stay. And whether we want to admit it or not, the black blot program has put its stigma on quite a few sports and Olympic stamps since it started in April 1962.

And over the years certain philatelic federations and organizations along with the sponsors of many exhibitions have either issued rules or have requested exhibitofs not to show black blotted items. As to the feasibility and the righteousness of their actions, it would appear to me that it is all in the eye of the beholder.

But think of the challenge it would be to form a sports and Olympic collection of just black blotted items. Financially this might get a bit costly, but the unique difference of such a collection along with the exacting research one would do in order to properly ascertain as to just why the APS did black blot them would be a herculean but worthwhile task.

The APS has now published a book listing all the black blots since 1962 thru 1977. The book is titled **"Black Blot 1962-1977"**, and was compiled by SPI member Barbara de Violini. The book sells for \$2.75 (\$2.20 to APS members), and is available from the APS, Box 800, State College, PA 16801.

If the bible of philately, Scott Catalogs can 'play' with various philatelic issues and list them as "only for the record", then we see no reason why the APS cannot have their play toy also in their Black Blot Program.

THE DAVID FELDMAN AUCTION

On June 27-30, 1978, the auction house of David Feldman, S.A. held an auction in Zurich of nearly 6,000 lots of prime material. Included were 107 lots of Olympic material. Some material was sold that is rarely offered. The demand for postal history was very strong. The material listed here is for Olympic items only. Prices are given in U.S. dollars with a 10% auctioneer's surcharge being included.

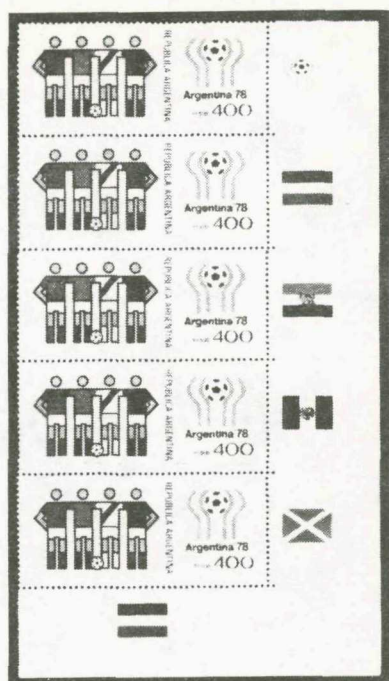
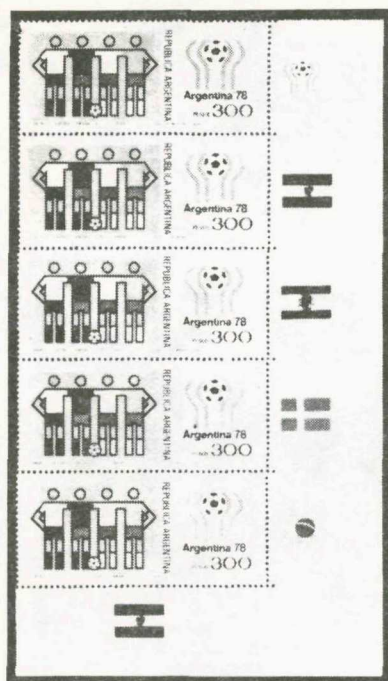

This is the first postal issue from Argentina that contains a "gimmick", to sell more and faster. It will be very interesting to see what the wholesale dealers will make-out of this issue, since the face value of it is quite low. Quantities issued on all Argentine World Cup stamps will be announced at a later day.

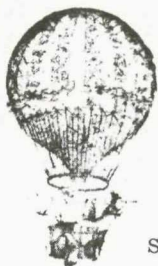


.... From Mexico. June 1st, 1978. Mexico issues a set of three values for World Cup '78. This is the Special Cancel, used on FDC's of that issue, black.

A-54 The question of "perfinned" sports and Olympic stamps seems to have struck a responsive chord from at least two members. Joe Schirmer is very interested in both the fields of "perfins" and precancels. He reports that at least 23 different perfins exist on the 1932 US Olympic stamp issues (Scott #s 716, 718 & 719.) He also informs me that Salvador has "perfinned" a sports set. "Perfins" are also used by some stamp printers on samples to prevent use and/or theft.

Dave Bressler has in his collection a cover from Paris branch of the Guaranty Trust Company of New York on which the 25¢ & 50¢ of the 1924 French Olympic issue (Scott # 199, 201) are "perfinned" with the initials "GT".

Any additional "perfinned" sports or Olympic stamps would be welcomed for listing in this column.

A-51. What is the most interesting item in my collection? Francesca Rapkin, a 1936 Berlin Olympic collector, from England responds, "I think that this is almost impossible to answer, so many items are interesting, some of them for personal reasons, and expense is not necessarily the criterion, nor rarity. Very often I have found that expense and rarity are not even related. I suppose that if I had to find the one most interesting item in my collection, it would be the piece that set me on the rocky road of Olympic collecting in the first place . . . if I could only remember which item it was!"

Q-60. I have heard that there was a special rocket flight to commemorate the 8th Olympic Winter Games in Squaw Valley, Calif. Is this true? Was there any philatelic material connected with this flight? If so, how many items were carried aboard the flight?

Q-61. Information about the 1952 Communist China "Gymnastics By Radio" issue is desired. Was the issue valid for postage or were they labels? If they were postage stamps how many stamps in the series were there? How did the program work?

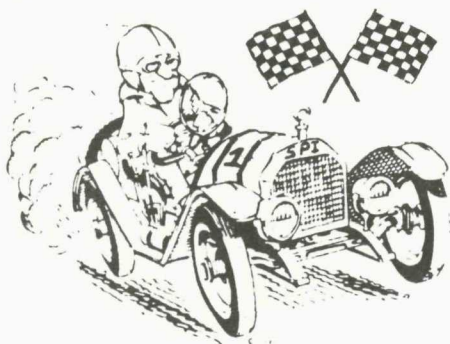

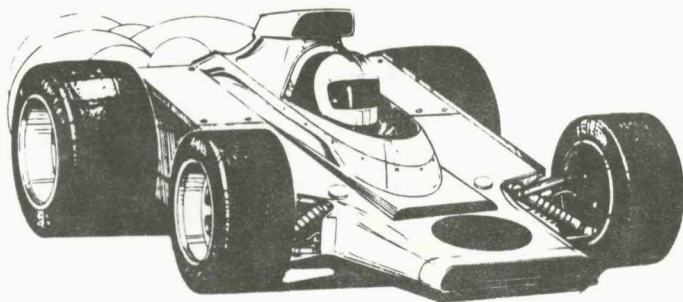

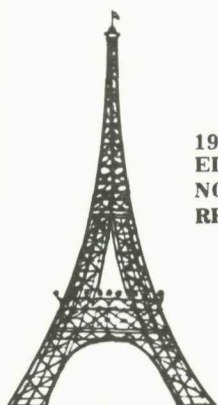
